Chameleon cook's corner - Eggnog and purple recipes

Eggnog has always been a holiday favorite.

rigoz. rum per serving (light or 151)

2-3 eggs per blander ful Milk (about 1 per blander ful)
dash of vanilla
dash of ginger or slight pinch of cloves if desired.

In a blender, mix eggs, milk & rum. Blender should now be about one third full. Add ice cream (and ginger or cloves if desired)
until blender is 2/3 full. Mix and taste. Add ice cream to desired consistency. Pour into glasses. Sprinkle nutmeg on top before serving.

Grape flavored gelatin dessert mandarin orange segments (drained)

While waiting, mix up whipped cream. Fold remaining gelatin into double volume of whipped cream. Top with one mandarin orange segment. Serve these within 6 hours or whipped cream will begin to deflate. Keep refrigerated.

HERBS THAT HEAL * GOLDENSEAL Hydrastis Canadensis

Certainly herbs have been used for many purposes through countless millenia of human history. The vast majority of human nutriment has been obtained by gathering (as opposed to hunting) and the lore concerning the properties of various plants was handed from mother to daughter and shaman to successor. Some plants were used for dyeing, others for tanning hides that were removed from the occasional animal the hunting groups managed to bring home. Some plants were able to stun fish or repel insects, or poison game (or enemies - see Italy/Borgias, Amazon dart poison). Some plants were found to induce sleep, ease pain, remove fatigue, give visions. But the plants that were most often used (aside from daily diet) were the healing herbs.

Goldenseal is indigenous to North America, and has long been revered as a valuable gift of the earth by Native Americans. Its brilliant yellow color makes for an excellent dye, and its healing powers are truly phenomenal. It is also used internally to stimulate appetite, purify the blood and liver, tone up the G.I. tract, clear up the lungs, heal mouth sores and inflamed tonsils, ease nausea due to pregnancy, and is also a tonic for "ailing organs." for men and women both. Externally it can be used for an excellent eyewash, any inflammations or infections (such as sties, boils, ringworm), wounds or rashes.

The root of the goldenseal plant (hydrastis canadensis, ranunculaceae) contains three major alkaloids: hydrastine, berberine and canadine (some of these structurally resemble the opium alkaloid papaverine). These physiologically active compounds are very powerful healing agents, but exceedingly large internal doses (over 1 teaspoon) can be toxic. Since relatively small amounts are effective, large doses are usually unneccessary.

For cuts and scrapes in the skin, just directly apply the pawder (it helps stop the bleeding and accelerates the healing process.) But a tincture or tea is often easier to apply and can be used for a variety of other ailments. The tincture is an alcohol extraction of the root, whereas the tea is a hot water extract. Filter out the solid powder, and you will have a beautiful yellow liquid. If you wish to store the tea for future use. refrigerate; the tincture will keep on the shelf. A few drops of the extract added to a glass of water makes a bitter tonic, an excellent gargle/rinse for sore throat, tooth extractions, and cold sores. When applied full strength to sties, the infection clears up within three days; diluted, the tea makes a soothing, healing eyewash (Until recently, Murine, an overthe-counter soothing eyewash, was yellow containing berberine and half-a-dozen preservatives), and, of course, the tea can be drunk in moderation as a bitter tonic, or the powdered root can be encapsulated (often with other herbs to buffer). Adding powdered goldenseal to a balm with a natural base (such as beeswax, to soak into the skin) is an excellent way to medicate chapped lips and hands, and help promote healing of physically damaged skin with less scar tissue.

another in your arms.


Again I go, out into the fields.

It should be remembered that any germ-killer used internally might affect the balance of beneficial bacteria in the colon, and an addition of natural yoghurt to the diet after any large internal use is advisable.

The availability of herbs like goldenseal to the general public is aided by the existence of organizations such as the Church of the Tree of Life, a non-sectarian, non-dogmatic organization dedicated to the expansion of awareness. They have declared that all non-controlled substances are sacrements of the church, thus protected by the bill of rights. 
DARK HORSE TAROT



We will be happy to send these additions to persons who purchased the deck before the boxes and coloring instructions were available. Please let us know a name and address, and where you purchased the deck.


