RECYCLE OR DIE

Recycling is mandatory in New York State! If you can take your trash home with you, plsase do!

For easy recycling:

- Rinse and separate as part of the cooking/eating process.
 Rinse or bag recyclables right away. (Keeps animals and bugs from your camp as well)!
- Bring recyclables to the recycling gathering points <u>DAILY</u>. Water for rinsing is available at both. See map for gathering points.
- Burn or bag paper right away. <<Be careful of flying ash.>>

Here's how to separate:

Aluminum (foil, pie plates, TV trays, beer/soda cans)
RINSE AND FLATTEN

New York State--5 cent deposit on specifically marked cans

Separate these from other cans, rinse and leave undamaged;
they can be returned to the local grocer for a refund.

Tin (steel) cans - Rinse, remove labels and ends, and flatten.

Glass - Separate by color (clear, amber, green). Rinse, remove metal rings. Labels may stay on.

Same as aluminum regarding New York State refund

Plastics - Containers with these symbols-







can be recycled. Rinse, remove hard caps and rings, flatten.

Non-Recyclables - Take other plastics and polystyrenes home with you if possible.

CHILD CARE CO-OP

If you will be using child care, you must sign up to help, since this is a co-op. Parents will be required to work one hour for every four hours their child/children are in the co-op (per family, not per child). Those not using the center are also welcome to sign up to fulfill their two hour volunteer work detail.

The hours for the child care co-op are currently 10 am-6 pm on most days, but may be shorter if not enough volunteers are available for adequate and effective staffing.

Duties include supervision of small children and possible assistance with children's programs.

Although some snacks will be provided (contributions are welcome), meals will not be available. Be considerate of both your children and care givers. Feed your children lunch. Be sure to leave any special supplies (like diapers) with the volunteers.

Sign-up sheets for all the above are at the registration table. Any questions may be directed to Sue Parker.

YOUNG HERALDS CLANS

Children B and up are welcome and encouraged to take part in announcing the programs. Children will be paired with adults to complete the rounds. There will be sign-up sheets at registration.

STORYTELLERS' GUILD

A very exciting and important part of this year's children's programming is the Storyteller's Guild. Story time will occur daily (Wed-Sat) at 2:00 pm at or near the Children's Care Co-op.

Both young and not so young are invited to tell or read stories. There will be some books available, or bring your own. Of course, children of ALL ages are welcome to come and listen to these wonderful tales.

STARWOOD 1991 WORKSHOP DESCRIPTIONS

AFRO-CUBAN DRUMMING - Samba Scouts

Learn Afro-Cuban rhythms, specifically samba from Brazil, Guanguanco from Cuba, and Yoruban from Nigeria. Participants will use bells, shakers, drums and voice.

AIKIDO AND UESHIBA'S ENLIGHTENMENT - Jim Klar

A demonstration of and introduction to the 20th century martial art of Aikido. Also examines the events in the founder's life that led to his enlightenment and creation of the art. Attendees will be expected to participate in non-strenuous Aikido exercises to experience blending and the flow of Ki (universal life force) in their bodies. Wear loose clothing and bring comfortable sit-upons.

ANCIENT GODDESSES: Recovering Our Lost Heritage - Morning Glory Zell For 2,000 years before God the Father was ever conceived, the human race revered a Great Mother who gave birth to Life itself and nourished everyone with the fruits of Her body. Morning Glory shares her collection of over 100 authentic votive Goddess figurines. When you handle a stone-age ivory carving or a bronze Lakshmi image from a modern Hindu shrine, you can feel a familiar echo in your heart as a lost treasure is restored to you.

ANIMAL SPIRIT CIRCLE - Morning Glory Zell

An experience in Shapeshifting. This popular circle, based on Morning Glory's work with the Council of All Beings work of Joanna Macy and John Seed, involves a shamanic transformation through our evolutionary journey. Will use entrainment drumming, somatic remembering and deep trancework to help reevolve into the various animal species.

AR NDRAIDCHT FEIN (ADF) INTERNATIONAL MEMBERS' MEETING - Isaac Bonewits Election of ADF's Members Advocate, and reports from the Mother Grove.

THE ART OF CELTIC ENCLOSURES - Brian Perrin
How to build a Celtic temple, and what kind of art was used in temples.

AUTHENTIC MOVEMENT - Larry Myers

What is now called 'authentic movement' was once part of a series of body-mind endeavors originated by Mary Starks Whitehouse. The term now refers to improvised dancing with eyes closed, usually without musical accompaniment, and with one or more 'witnesses.'

AWARENESS THROUGH MOVEMENT: The Feldenkrais Method - Jonathan Smith The Feldenkrais Methods--sequences of gentle, comfortable movement explorations--will help you reconnect with your natural ability to move. It will help you improve posture and breathing; reduce stress, tension and fatigue; ease pain and stiffness; and develop efficient and flexible movement.

BALANCE AND TRANSFORMATION - Nema

The open secret of Magick and other systems of Initiation is personal transformation. Included in this workshop are milestones on the path of Initiation, symptoms of success and failure in achieving new levels of consciousness, and the Priest's function in the process of progress.

BECOMING A DRUID PRIEST/ESS - Isaac Bonewits

The Ar nDraiocht Fein (ADF) study and training system provides structured learning in Druidic paths. This talk explains the course and how to begin.

BEGINNING RITUAL DRUMMING - Richard Keenan

Drumming brings magic and energy to ritual. An introductory workshop to simple drumming techniques for ritual use.

BEING PSYCHIC - Rebecca Crystal

Begins with a short lecture and a demonstration. The majority of the workshop will consist of experiential exercises, starting with sensing your own aura and progressing to partner and group work. Relaxation, psychometry and telepathy will be included.

BERDACHE: Spirits on the Land - Phoenix

Native American views on gender, role and spirituality. A discussion of the application of the Berdache principles to our modern community.

BODY MUSIC - Karen Allgire

Explores the use of the body & voice to produce sounds, create rhythms and experience self awareness and group interaction. Clapping, clicking, stomping, vocalizing and walking will be combined in interlocking and mesmerizing patterns.

CHADS, FRACTALS AND THE MAGICAL WORLDVIEW - Andrew Hoerner

A multimedia exploration of the world of fractals and nonlinear dynamics. (These computer-generated images and videos are truly cool). The mathematical study of feedback and chaotic (turbulent) processes is leading to some interesting parallels to traditional western magical theory. Video flight through the mathematical models of chaos. High school algebra helpful but not essential. Hand-out and reading list will be distributed.

ELECTRO-MEDICINE, MASSAGE AND MIRACLES - Donna Boswell

Massage and electro-medicine are individually powerful healing tools. Together they are unbeatable. Explore the healing possibilities in this hands-on seminar.

COSMOLOGY OF THE INDO-EUROPEANS - Isaac Bonewits

Discussion on the background structure of the pagan world-view.

THE COUNCIL OF WEE PEOPLE - Rainbow Weaver

This ancient Native American teaching tool for young children tries to answer the questions children ask (Eg: Why is the sky blue and why do birds fly south?). Story telling, singing, dancing, games and crafts help inspire creativity and positive self image that carry the children through their lives.

CRAFTING ALTAR FIGURES - Rainbow Weaver

Native Americans and other nationalities have used altars in ceremonies for centuries. Suggestions for and examples of bringing altar ceremonies into your daily life will be offered. Guides for creating our personal altar sculpture intended for use on our special altar will be provided. Bring any personal objects you may wish to incorporate into your piece, or share with the circle.

CRANIOSACRAL THERAPY - Kathleen Amber

Considers the root causes (other than symptoms) of physical, emotional and emergetic dysfunctions, discusses contact with the 'inner physician,' and addresses the ethics of this connection and its use for healing. Includes energy channeling.

DANCE IMPROVISATION - Karen Allgire

Will explore ways of discovering our own spontaneous impulses for creative movement and group interaction.

DANCING YOUR MAGICK ~ Kenneth Deigh

A workshop on the magickal use of your body, using a visualization of the body as process. There will be a series of exercises in Authentic Movement (Alexander Technique); individual expression through movement; movement with a partner, and movement in a group.

DEEPENING THE ADF LITURGY - Isaac Bonewits


Ar nDraiocht Fein (ADF) looks at the newest models of our basic ceremony, and discusses grove ritual.

DREAM FEATHER - Rainbow Weaver (\$10 fee)

A workshop for manifesting your dreams and goals in the physical world. Dreams can be tapped through the use of a dream feather, since feathers are the messengers of peace from the winged ones. Rainbow Weaver will guide participants in crafting personal dream feathers using natural materials. Bring your drums and rattles.

By changing one's language systems, one can effect internal transformations. Discusses how to reformulate one's world-view through careful observation and use of language.

LEMONADE SOCIAL - William Kates

Dress up in your finest dancing attire, bring some juice and snacks and come on down. The music is especially selected to keep kids hopping, bopping, leaping and spinning. No Mr. Rogers. Sesame Street. Raffi or other overly cute. calm-evoking music is planned. Preschoolers should bring an adult along. This event is brought to you by Run-m-Ragged Productions.

MAGIC, MUSIC AND SACRED MASSAGE - Richard Keenan

A combination of pagan ritual and massage technique. Skyclad participants should bring old blankets, pillows and possibly a ritual candle. Massage oil, music and instructions will be provided. spiritual women are celebrating the Goddess and themselves.

An old game with a new twist - a rather unique setting.

SECRETS OF TELESMATIC MAGICK - Donald Michael Kraig
The lesser-known techniques of the telesmatic magick within the Golden Dawn
system. Gives information necessary to fully work that system.

SEIDR MAGIC - Paul Maurice

The shamanic magical tradition of the Vanir, and its place in the Norse traditions.

THE SEVEN AFRICAN POWERS RITUAL AND DANCE – Jamie Perry Will call down the major deities of the pantheon used for healing and other good clean fun.

SEX AND MAGICK FOR GAY AND LESBIAN GROUPS - Phoenix Explores problems and solutions encountered in working with a 'same-sex' coven.

SHAMAN AS CRAFTSMAN - Steven Starsparks

Transforming matter into spirit--10 years as Bear Tribe Medicine Wheel Silversmith. "As a Shamanic designer, I utilize my life experience as a formal student and practioner of shamanism to invigorate and vitalize my designs as a form of prayer made manifest in materiality."

SHAMANIC DRUMMING - Larry Doe An introduction to shamanic drumming for ritual purposes.

SHAMANIC JOURNEY POSITIONS - Nikki Bado

Shamanic journey based on techniques developed by Felicitas Goodman, author of <u>Where the Spirits Ride the Wind</u>. Exploration of the Singing Shaman position. Wear loose clothing and bring writing paper and pen.

SHEYA MAGICK - Kenneth Deigh

A New Aeon System, which combines movement, meditation and invocation of the architypes. Explore this modern aesthetic approach to the traditional goals of self transformation.

THE SILVER STAR - Richard Kaczynski

One of the most popular and important magical systems to build upon the Golden Dawn is known variously as the Argentium Astrum, A.'A.', or Silver Star. This talk traces the historical roots of the A.'A.', from the Golden Dawn and Aleister Crowley to its present forms. Like any living organism, our nation is subject to live cycles and the aging process. At the end of the millenium, the US is on the brink of unprecedented transformation.

BUFI DANCING - Madonna Moonhawk

Have you ever heard of the 'Whirling Dervishes?' The term describes Sufi dancing and that 'whirl.' Uses movement and song as tools to attain a higher plane. Come join us while we dance, twirl and sing.

SWEAT LODGE - Joseph Rothenberg

This is a canvas structure using heated rocks and water to produce a dark, warm, meditative environment. The sweat lodge, in one form or another, has been used by many European and Native American cultures. If you are interested in running a sweat, on the theme of your choice, contact Joseph for scheduling throughout the weekend. Times will be posted in front of the lodge.

T'AI CHI - Marty Laubach

A demonstration of T'ai Chi form and a chance for participants to get a taste of 'Push Hands,' an exercise in the awareness of the dynamics of balance in the self and in the practice partner. Discussion topics will include T'ai Chi's relationship to meditation, exercise and defense, and its relationship to 'magical' energy as a practical and experiential form.

THE TSLAGI DANCE OF LIFE - Don Waterhawk

A grounding, centering, balancing and gratitude dance—a meditation with movement, very much like T'ai Chi. It is a sacred medicine dance from the eastern Cherokee tradition.

THE VOICE OF THE PLANET - Video

Starring William Shatner and Faye Dunaway. A computer hacker signing the name 'Gaia' lures an Ecologist to a Tibetan monastary, where the actual Earth Goddess magically/technologically sends him on a quest across time and space. A 5-part fantasy video series.

WALKING IN HARMONY ON THE PATHWAY OF PEACE - Rainbow Weaver (\$10 fee) In today's Earth changes, it helps to have a firm focus on our own medicine (gifts and abilities), so we can walk in harmony with nature and our own environment. First we must begin with Our Sacred Space. Rainbow Weaver will share the ancient wisdom of Turtle Island, and weave you within to your place of remembering. Bring your drums, rattles, etc.

THE WAY OF THE ORISHAS: The African Gods of Santeria - Jamie Perry Will discuss the Gods of the Yoruban tribe of Nigeria and Benin (the same deities used in the traditions of Santeria, Candalomble of Brazil, Shango of Trinidad and Lucumi of the Louisiana swamps), and the way they are worshipped. Aims to break the barrier of fear brought on by the media and the uninitiated.

WITCHCRAFT: Philosophy and Practice - Jade

Women practicing feminist magic have developed their own ethic, worldview, and a theology that is woman-centered and life-affirming. Discusses ways to bring this philosophy into women's lives through the practice of Women's Witchcraft.

THE WORK OF THE MASK: Opening the Interface - Larry Doe (\$30 fee) Mask-making is a way to reach the intensely internal, to make it physically manifest, and bring it out into the public for our own look at our Self. The making of a personal mask will open the flow of energy in both directions (from inner to outer and from outer to inner).
