

PLEASE read and abide by these simple rules.

- 1. STARWOOD IDENTIFICATION Must be worn at all times during the event. Those who don't jeopardize their right to remain. NO ENTRY TO WORKSHOPS WITHOUT THIS ID:
- 2. VEHICLES Car IDs must be properly displayed at all times. After unloading, please immediately move your vehicle to the Parking Area across the road from the entrance. Camping/merchant vehicles that MUST stay on-site MUST be approved by Starwood Staff, and should be left there until Sunday afternoon or departure. NO non-staff vehicle traffic is allowed in the camping area from 1-8AM.
- 3. DISRUPTIVE/HARMFUL BEHAVIOR Will not be tolerated! Privacy must be respected! DO NOT take pictures or videotape anyone without their express permission (NO candid or crowd pictures). NO cameras allowed at the Bonfire. Failure to accept this rule may result in your expulsion from Starwood with NO REFUND.
- **4. RESTRICTED AREAS** NO loud noise/music in QUIET CAMPING after 10:30 PM. All-night drumming is restricted to proper areas. REFER TO MAP. Do not camp in any NO CAMPING areas (You will be relocated). REFER TO MAP. Sky Clad area is up to the back of the Shower House. Wear clothing when going to the ice coolers, cook house, and/or parking area. REFER TO MAP.
- 5. WOODS fires in the woods without prior permission from the OWNER is extremely dangerous and STRICTLY PROHIBITED! Shoes are strongly recommended. Please stay on marked paths, especially at night.
- **6. FIRE** Don't leave candles, grills, etc. unattended. Firepits are OK but MUST be filled in before leaving. Leave standing trees alone! Don't burn recyclables, recycle them!
- **7. 2-HOUR VOLUNTEERS** Your 2-hour workshift is appreciated (and necessary). Sign up promptly for best times, and be on time! This helps the event run smoothly, and helps make Starwood a real community.
- **8. DEPENDENTS** Children are your responsibility and must be closely supervised AT ALL TIMES, especially at the Swimming Area. Please read the Next Generation Book thoroughly. Be sure to SIGN WAIVERS for all your dependents. DOGS ARE NOT WELCOME THIS YEAR.
- **9. TONE DOWN IN TOWN** If you go into town keep your Starwood gear, clothing, and image at Starwood. Please do not feed or tease the locals. This rule does not supercede Rule Number 1.
- 10. RECORDING OR VIDEOTAPING of music and workshops for commercial purposes, other than by A.C.E., is strictly prohibited.
- 11. HONOR THE LAND! Refer to the Recycling Section. Pick up any trash you find and clean your camparounds thoroughly before you leave.
- 12. POOL & SPA Be aware of Pool House hours. Children under 16 must be accompanied by their parents at all times in the pool and spa. Be aware of Pool House rules (they're posted). You must hose off or shower before entering the water. NO ALCOHOL is allowed in the pool area. Please read the Pool House Rules.
- 13. HAVE FUN, but play safe. Watch your sun exposure, drink plenty of water, and look out for the Eirst A a Tent.



Starwood features an incredible selection of entertainment, day and night, including music, movies, theatre, comedy and pure fun.

TUESDAY, after the **Opening Circle** and the **Opening of the Nemeton**, we'll gather at the Gruple Dome for the **Welcome Wagon Drum Jam**, the official beginning of the ever-present Starwood percussion. Bring your drums and shake your bones!

WEDNESDAY's Lunchtime concert will feature Todd Alan and the Quest, and the evening activities include rock music by Ya-Men-Ja, the full-length animated eco-adventure Fern Gully: the Last Rainforest, and the world-beat video-crazed Starwood Dance Party DJ'd by Bruce Florist and Sade LeMaerin. (A Keening Circle will be held at sunset in the Faerie Woods).

THURSDAY's Lunchtime Concert slot will feature **Street Drumming**, a unique percussion troupe, and the evening **Bardic Concert** will begin with a special appearance by Earth First! eco-Bard **Darryl Cherney**. (Don't forget the **Faerie Circle** at sunset in the Faerie Woods, and the **Midnight Lughnassadh Ritual** offered by A.D.F.)

FRIDAY at Lunch we'll hold the first Starwood Kids Koncert: a selection of performances for the Next Generation by the Starwood family of entertainers. After dinner the Parti-Gras Parade will wind its way to the Pavilion for the Main Concert, with Chameleon Bard Ian Corrigan, Magic & percussion by Spinner & Magnus, exotic world music by Nada Brahma, the sounds of the many elven folk by Shaman, and festival rock by Ya-Men-Ja: To top off the bill, the multi-media musical/metallic pyro-artists Testburn will light the island with Burning Bridges.

SATURDAY at Lunchtime Rev. Ivan Stang and the Church of the SubGenius will hold a live Hour of Slack Radio Show, and just after dinner he'll join members of the Chameleon Club in a performance of the Firesign Theatre radio play "The Further Adventures of Nick Danger, Third Eye." Our pre-Bonfire Concert will feature the 3rd Annual Starwood Jam, followed by the Tribal-Rock percussion of Tribe of Spirit. Then the moment we've all been waiting for, as Karen Allgire leads the Firelighting Procession and Ceremony for the World's Greatest Bonfire Party! Yee-ha!



We are creating a good sized village, and working together is the only way we can make the task of trash disposal easy.

Recycling drop-off points are marked on the map and should be easy to find all around the village. Each point has several large labeled bins and a box for propane cylinders and aerosol cans.

RECYCLE DAILY!! <u>This is essential!</u> After previous Starwoods, there've been mountains to dispose of with no one left to help! Your bag of recycling may not look like much, but there are 1000 or more similar bags around the village! Bring it to a recycling point and drop it off EVERY DAY.

RINSE! All recyclables MUST be rinsed. Unrinsed bottles and cans plus heat make perfect breeding grounds for those of the Goddesses' creatures we all prefer not to have around.

SEPARATE! into:

Burnables: All paper and other burnable trash. Please burn it near your campsite. This does NOT include propane cylinders or aerosol cans (think BOMB!) Cylinders and spray cans should be taken home or dropped in the boxes provided at the recycling drop off points.

Compost: Please wash your dishes at the sinks provided behind the "four-flushers". DO NOT use the sinks in the showerhouse for this purpose (The plumbing simply will not handle it!) If you wash dishes at your camp, pour the water off at least 50 feet from a lake or stream.

Deposit bottles and cans: These receive a 5 cent deposit in the state of New York and are so marked. Please place all deposit bottles AND cans in the "Deposit Only" bins. Don't crush deposit cans, but please rinse.

Non-deposit glass: All glass containers which do not carry a deposit in NY should be put in these bins.

Non-deposit aluminum: All non-deposit aluminum containers should be crushed and placed in these bins.

Garbage (or true trash): Alas, some things are still entering the waste stream. Everything else goes in these bins, including plastic & steel food cans. PLEASE don't flush diapers, tompons or sanitary pads! Use trash cans next to the toilets.

Recycling workshift volunteers are worshiped (and they have great Karma, too!)

Speaker Bios & Workshop Descriptions

KAREN ALLGIRE, M.F.A.

...is a professional dancer, teacher, singer and choreographer dedicated to sharing the joy of voice and movement. She teaches dance at Cleveland State University and has taught extensively at Pagan gatherings since 1986.

Ritual Dance

An exploration of simple dance movement combined with clearly focused awareness and intention. The dance that participants will be learning will be part of the Saturday night Bonfire Lighting Ceremony, so if you want to be a part of the magic circle dance, come to either workshop.

Bonfire Lighting Ceremony Rehearsal

For torch bearers, dancers and drummers. If you want to drum for the ceremony, please be at this rehearsal.

KEN ANOFF

...leader of **Tribe of Spirit** was initially inspired by the tabla drums of North India, and later by the rich drumming traditions of Africa and Latin America, and he's brought those concepts to the Western drum set. He modified the standard format of the "trap set" to include the softer, more melodious sounds of tom-toms, timbale, cowbells, ago-go bells and wood blocks. The result is a whole body of songs that have been created with complex multi-linear rhythms, singing and chanting to create a unique sound that is at the same time ancient and entirely new. He is also a member of **Nada Brahma**. Ken now teaches percussion at his alma mater, the University of Maryland (Baltimore), where he graduated with a major in percussion.

Understanding Rhythm

Ken will teach a systematic approach for a greater understanding and appreciation of rhythm particularly in its relationship to drumming. Bring a drum if you have one. No prior drumming experience is necessary.

CLIFF BERNS

...is a licensed massage therapist and a Reiki practitioner. He recently discovered he has a body and has been very busy exploring the possibilities this provides for his healing and growth. When he grows up he would like to become a peaceful man and a fine healer. Thanks Ma!

Shakti Puja Workshop

Ciff and Ian Corrigan will do the groundwork needed to prepare a communal worship and celebration of the Goddess. If you would like to actively participate, here is an opportunity for you. We will grow and give birth to this experience as a group. The puja ritual will take place later; this workshop will prepare us, and is a prerequisite to it.

ISAAC BONEWITS

...is the Archdruid of Ár nDraíocht Féin: A Druid Fellowship (ADF). He has been a Druid priest for almost 25 years, and is well known in the Neopagan community as an author, teacher, bard and leader. His first book, *Real Magic*, is a classic in the field of occult studies, and he's currently working on a book about Liturgy for Harper Collins.

Varieties of Initiatory Experience

People in the New Age, magical, metaphysical, and Neopagan communities frequently refer to "initiation", but few seem to have a very clear idea of just what an initiation is or should be. Isaac will talk about 3 overlapping types of genuine initiation, their differences and similarities, and he'll advise initiators and initiates on how to get the most out of their experiences.

Authentic Thaumaturgy: Magic for Gamers

In this presentation, Isaac will talk about the difference between real world magic and game magic, explain some of the basic principles behind magic as it has been traditionally practiced, and give insights into the characteristic personalities of different sorts of magic users. He'll explain the A.T. system of game magic, show how to adapt it to various games, and demonstrate the procedures for players to create "spell recipes" unique to their favorite game characters.

Merlin and the Druids

A discussion of historical and fictional ideas about Merlin and his relationship, if any, to the paleo-Pagan Druids of Britain.

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DONNA BOSWELL, L.M.T.

...is a Chameleon Club member, a certified Alpha-Stim technician, licensed massotherapist, researcher and president of the Ohio State Massage Therapy Ass'n.

Finding the Healer Within

Each of us has the ability for healing, whether for ourselves, or for others. Donna will teach short meditations and rituals for accessing that healing wellspring, and for focusing that ability.

DAVID BUTLER

Gay and Pagan?

...has been a practitioner of the healing arts for over 16 years.

DARRYL CHERNEY

...Earth First! troubadour, has been entertaining activists in the front lines of the timber wars in Northern California for eight years. Alongside Judi Bari, he lived through a car-bombing for which the FBI unsuccessfully attempted to frame the two of them (They are currently suing). His upbeat, humorous songs continue to inspire those laboring to defend our Mother Earth. His original songs like "You Can't Clear-cut Your Way to Heaven", "Jesus Was a Mushroom", and "Earth First!" combine a Pagan perspective with the urgency to protect our planet.

Activism as Ritual—The Craft of Protest

Does loving our dying Mother Earth without defending her make us just a bunch of New Age necrophiliacs? Do eco-activists who deny their Paganism uproot themselves from the most powerful source of ideas and energy they can tap into? This workshop will bring to the surface the ritualistic aspects of protests and attempt to break down the fear and barriers many Pagans have about becoming activists and, likewise, the barriers activists have in acknowledging their Paganism in defending our blessed Earth.

NORM CHRISTIANSEN

...has a B.S. in Biology, and is privately known as Chameleon's Mad Scientist. His interests of research include physiology of plants and consciousness exploration. He is a storyteller and babysitter for hungry and hungover Chameleons. Once again, Norm will attempt Radio-Free Starwood. Stay tuned.

Legal Highs and Psychoactive Plants

Norm will cover the legal aspects of un-scheduled psychoactive plants, how they can be obtained or grown, what they're chemical make-up is and how they effect the nervous system.

Storyhour

Norm has learned many tales from around the world and from many different cultures, come listen to him weave myths and stories in this workshop for both adults and children. Check the children's schedule for time & place.

COLLEEN CLARK

. is an artist/dancer who began her formal training in front of a motorola television set watching American Bandstand, received a B.F.A. from Ohio State University and "slipped into" Pagan Consciousness during the process of creating and performing a feminist work in which she danced naked covered with Mud. She is currently an M.F.A. candidate at Case Western Reserve University.

Contact Improvisation

A gentle, healing, energizing "art/sport" that involves moving spontaneously with another person while maintaining an ever-shifting point of contact. Regular practice sharpens the mind, awakens the senses, accesses intuition and opens the heart to greater communication on many levels.

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SKIP CLARK, Ph.D.

Professor of history at St. Andrews College in Laurinburg, North Carolina, and teaching a class there in Witchcraft and Women, Dr. Clark has researched extensively in Medieval Medical Astrology, and has taught in China and in Italy.

The Burning Times

Focusing on the reasons for the outbreak of persecutions in the 17th century and why they stopped, the victims, their common characteristics, and where and why the stereotype of the "witch" arose.

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CLEVELAND AIKIKAI

An interest and a desire to learn are the only requirements to begin Aikido training. Neither physical prowess, agility or age are factors in deciding when to begin training. Strength and speed are not essential elements of Aikido. Therefore, it is an ideal martial art for men, women and children of all ages and physical abilities. The Cleveland Aikikai welcomes all students of Aikido, regardless of style or previous affiliation.

BILL KING

...has 12+ years of experience in the Japanese martial art of Aikido. He is chief instructor of the Cleveland Aikikai.

Aikido Workshop

Aikido is an effective discipline for the integration and utilization of one's physical, mental and spiritual potential. Aikido is not a sport. Instead it is a method of strengthening one's mind and body. Aikido technique combines practical self-defense movements from traditional Japanese sword, spear, Jujitsu and other martial arts. To participate, wear comfortable clothes, bring something comfortable to sit on.

Make Love To Your Food Until It Is You

Did you know radishes levitate to Mahler's Ninth Symphony? Did you know broccoli is the easiest vegetable to channel? From the Internet to PODS, meet your cyber-pals in the flesh. Catch up on the latest technology. Bring laptops, disks to swap, or anything that fits the bill. Last year's talk ran itself, so we'll keep the anarchy going and let the people run the show.

BILL KATES

...is a certified SubGenius Radio Pagan, raised in the woods of Lower Westchester County, NY, by his dog, Flapjack, and his understanding parents, Edith and Victor. Currently living and working in N.Y.C., Bill creates "promos", radio spots and comedy theater pieces for a major market radio station and does sound for films and theater, as well as helping to raise his two beautiful children, Cory and Sylvia. He collects horrible music and bad videotapes, and is well known as a field tester of new rodent species. At least one of his alter egos will be making his first appearance at this year's festival.

Exploring Theatrical Extremes

Bill will lead an improvisational workshop incorporating aspects of the Grotowski method... "make-your-own-theater-in-an-instant-out-of-your-own-brain".

RICHARD KEENAN, Ph.D.

...has been involved in magic and magical work for several years. He has offered classes on massage and other topics at may A.C.E. events. He has studied and participated in festival drumming since 1987.

Magic, Music, And Sacred Massage

This workshop is a combination of Pagan Ritual and massage technique. The workshop needs a secluded and shaded space. It will be coed and skyclad. (Oit will be applied to participants; clothes get in the way). While the workshop will be skyclad, sexual activity will NOT be permitted. Participants should bring old blankets or towels and possibly a pillow. A ritual candle is welcome. I will bring massage oil, music, and directions. A circle will be cast, divinities invoked, and massage technique will be done with rotating partners.

Abortion Ritual Design

Abortion is a necessary rite of passage for 1.5 million American women each year. Other rites of passage, like births, weddings, and deaths are observed with ceremony, sacrament, and ritual. Abortion has been largely ignored, but it shouldn't be. In this workshop we'll ask for input on design of ritual around the issue of abortion. A good ritual experience will help us grow through abortion and help our psychic, spiritual, emotional, and religious growth. The workshop will be primarily shared discussion.

Gay Spirit Symbols: From Rabbits to Rings

The Other Side of Tantra

Most people think that Tantra is simply the "yoga of sex". In actuality, Tantra is a complete spiritual science and way of life in which sexuality is only a part. This workshop will share some of the other aspects of Tantra including why we are unhappy, Tantric meditation and psychic energy manipulation, and Tantric magick.

You're a What? (Dealing With Mundanes in Public and Private Life)

Somebody finds out that you are a Pagan or following a magickal lifestyle. "What's wrong with you? Are you crazy?" they ask. This workshop will discuss how to deal with friends and associates when you come out of the magickal closet. Also covered will be how to deal with the media when you've gone public. Bring your experiences to share.

MARTY LAUBACH

...is one of the founders of the Crystal Serpent (a Bloomington ritual magick group) and the Bloomington CUUPs chapter, and was an Elder for the ELF Lore Family from 1985 to 1992, working as the editor the Elven Chronicles newsletter, coordinator of public relations, and keeper of the financial and membership data. Marty was co-organizer of the "Tree of Life" rituals at WinterStar 1983 and ELF Fest 1990, the "Eleven Star" working at WinterStar 1984, and the community funeral rite at ELF Fest 1990. Marty has practiced Tai Chi since 1976, using William Chen's adoption of Cheng Man-Ch'ing long and short forms. He has been a senior student at the Tai Chi Association of Indiana and with IU's Tai Chi club, and has focused on Push Hands and Boxing. Marty is currently working with Black Moon Publications on financial systems and computer networking.

Tai Chi Workshop

Tai Chi Chuan is an exercise, moving meditation, and a martial art form that has been practiced in China since the 11th century. It uses Taoist principles of the soft overcoming the hard, emphasizing yielding and turning an opponent's own strength against themselves.

The Tai Chi workshop will occur daily at 9:30. It will start with a demonstration of William Chen's short form, and then provide an opportunity for other practitioners to demonstrate other variations of the forms. We will the progress to "push hands", an exercise in awareness of the dynamics of balance in the self and in a partner, and provide training for beginners and opportunities for exchange in free form pushing for Tai Chi practitioners.

LISA LEFKORT

...is a Chameleon and a true SubGenius Beautant. She is a volunteer for the Food Co-Op in Cleveland and always has a hug and a smile for friends. Lisa also co-designs A.C.E. literature (this year's Starwood cover is her concept) with J.R. and Jeff Rosenbaum.

SADE Le MAERIN

...is a shape-shifting dragon in the shape of a human. She can only hold one shape for 40 years maximum. Soon she will change back to the shape she was born in unless she decides to change within 5 years. In her dragon shape she can destroy anything within 10 miles, so don't get on her bad side. Opening Circle

We will begin our festival by calling on the Gods and Goddesses, creating a community, creating protection around the site, and lighting a psychic beacon for travelers who haven't made it here yet.

Closing Circle

Closes down the festival in a magical way, thanking the Gods and Goddesses, Spirits, Elementals, and every possible entity we can think of, and the land. We will send out protective light to accompany us on our homeward travels. We'll pat ourselves on the back, and, oh yeah, make last minute announcements.

MISHLEN LINDEN

...approaches percussion from the perspective of both a drummer and dancer. She wrote most of the drum pieces for the Inner Traditions Release, *Festival and Ritual Drumming*.

Festival & Ritual Drumming

Instruction in African, MidEastern, and rhythms used at the Rampart Street Spiritual Voodoo Temple, New Orleans. Group discussion centering on the emergence of festival drumming as a "style" of drumming much in the same way "jazz" and "rock" have generated styles of drumming. Bring a drum & tape recorder if possible.

DEBORAH LIPP

...has been Wiccan for over 13 years, and a Gardnerian High Priestess for 7 years. She lectures on a wide variety of topics and has taught numerous study groups and classes. She is also a writer, poet and storyteller.

Modern Mythology

The ancients had Gilgamesh and Isis, we have Superman and Captain Kirk. An exploration of the presence of ancient mythic themes in modern stories.

MICHAEL LOOS

...a botanist who works for the Ohio State Extension in Cuyahoga County, has special interests in plant taxonomy of native and horticultural species, and bonsai. Personal projects include include propagation of native trees and other rare plant species, including cycads, which are some of the oldest living plants (dinosaur fodder).

Nature Walk

A course in local flora, including woody and herbaceous plants, especially their conservation and environmental relationships. We will mark and place a boundary around any rare species we find. Please wear appropriate clothing, and bring your favorite guide to flora.

MERLIN DE DRACONIS MacATHANOR

...is High Priest of the Coven of the Keltic Sword & Stone (First coven in Ohio to be part of Covenant of the Goddess) and is a 12 year Keltic Traditionalist, initiated into Witchcraft 23 years ago. Merlin is a teacher of ritual & traditional craft. He has brought several witches to 3rd degree who have since hived off to form their own covens. Merlin is also known for his work in Silversmithing and Past Life Regression.

The Mystery Of The Drawing Down Of The Moon And Sun: The Ancient Art of Channeling the Lady and Lord

Together with High Priestess **Lady Ygraine**, High Priest Lord Merlin present a workshop that is designed to both educate the inexperienced and invite the experienced to a forum on the Drawing Down Rite as practiced in the Traditional Craft. An open discussion of the process and the experience of Drawing Down or opening oneself as a channel to the Gods. Ultimately the goal will be to plan a private ritual for those interested that will incorporate the Drawing Down.

YGRAINE ALARIA MacATHANOR

...has been involved in the Craft and the Pagan movement for thirteen years. She is a 3rd Degree Celtic traditional Witch and High Priestess of the Coven of the Keltic Sword and Stone, a Cleveland-based coven that offers an intensive Initiatory Path of Self-Mastery and daily devotion to the Celtic Old Gods. Formerly a Dianic Witch, Ygraine has worked in a polarity-based Celtic Witchcraft System for six years. In addition to training Wiccan apprentices, Ygraine is a dancer, weaver, spinner, Tarot reader, herbalist, and mother of three Pagan children. Ygraine has given workshops at other festivals and events exploring Goddess-spirituality, dance movement for chakra awareness, and Pagan parenting. Ygraine hopes by integrating work with Women's Spirituality and Traditional Wiccan polarity-based magick to help create a Craft for the future that both genders find equally enlightening, empowering, and fulfilling.

Tryst With The Horned One:

A Workshop for Women Exploring and Inviting the Male Polarity in the Universe

This women-only workshop will examine our feelings as women about the Male Force in the Universe. For most women work in the Craft is Goddess-focused. In this workshop women will explore their experience of the God-force as Lover, Consort, Father, Brother, Trickster, Lord of Wild Places and Vegetation, and Conductor of the Souls of the Dead. She has special emphasis on integrating psychotherapy, bodywork, guided meditation and expressive arts.

Holistic Body Work Techniques

Drawing on her extensive knowledge of body work therapy, she will explain the basics of such modalities as gestalt, bio-energetics, polarity therapy, reiki, shamanic journeys, sound healing, and psychosynthesis.

Circle of Song

Come celebrate! Open your heart and spirit through sacred song, dance, chanting, toning, drumming, music improvisation, ritual and healing for personal/planetary transformation Learn simple circle dances and music from many global sources (Native American, Pagan, Goddess, Buddhist, Sufi, etc.) drawn from the new book *Circle of Song—Songs, Chants*, and Dances for Ritual and Celebration.

MICHAEL MARKUS, B.M.

...is a percussionist and drummer. He currently teaches West African style drumming and continues his studies in African drumming and dance along with the study of Shoalin Wu Shu Gung Fu, Tai Chi, and Chi Gung. His unique teaching style incorporates all his studies into his workshops, giving each participant the tools they need to cultivate their energy and nurture their own creativity as they experience the rhythm of the drum.

Kung Fu for Drummers

This class is about generating power specifically for drumming, rather than learning self-defense. Classic structure from Shoalin Wu Shu systems will be applied as well as Chinese methods for stretching and conditioning. This class is a workout; be prepared to stretch and sweat.

Rhythms from West Africa (Guinea)

This class focuses on learning traditional rhythms from Guinea West Africa. Emphasis is on sustaining a rhythm, hearing how each part fits together, and making correct sounds on the drum.

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LOUIS MARTINÉ

...teaches Special Education and percussion for the Orleans Parish school system. He drums with the Rampart Street Spiritual Voodoo Temple, the Mombo Muslima, and for the ritual shows of the Voodoo Museum. He has written *Waters of Return; Aeonic Voodoo*, the text for the *New Orleans Voodoo Tarot*, and is the editor for Black Moon Publishing.

New Orleans Voodoo

After graduation he traveled extensively in the Asian and New World Tropics, becoming specialized in the shamanism and ethno-medicine of the Amazon Basin. With his brother Dennis, he is author of The Archaic Revival, The Invisible Landscape and Psilocybin: The Magic Mushroom Growers' Guide. A book of his Amazon adventures, True Hallucinations, is his most recent book. His interviews and essays can be found in such magazines as Magical Blend, Green Egg, and Psychedelic Illuminations. Currently he lives in Hawaii and California. He is the founding secretary-treasurer of Botanical Dimensions, a tax-exempt, non-

profit research botanical garden and gene bank devoted to the collection and propagation of plants of ethno-pharmacological interest. Currently he divides his time between writing, lecturing and occasionally performing at raves.

(Expressing Our Natures) a Transgendered Support Group located in Syracuse, NY.

Pathworking

Incorporated in 1968, CAW became the first Neo-Pagan church to obtain full Federal recognition in the U.S. He was the first to apply the terms "Pagan" and Neo-Pagan" to the newly emerging Nature Religions of the 1960's, and through his editorship of *Green Egg* (1968-1975; 1988-) Otter was instrumental in the coalescence of the Neo-Pagan movement. ROBERT SHEA 1933-1994

Bob Shea, co-author of the germinal Illuminatus! trilogy and author of many other historical and heretical writing, died of cancer in the arms of friends and his loving wife, Patricia Monaghan, after a sudden dramatic decline in his health. His last words before sinking into a coma were, "Love is everywhere."

Robert Joseph Shea attended Manhattan Prep, Manhattan College and Rutgers University and worked as a magazine editor in New York and Los Angeles. In the 60's he edited the *Playboy* Forum where he met Robert Anton Wilson, with whom he collaborated on *Illuminatus!* After publishing *Illuminatus!*. Bob left Playboy to become a full time novelist. His novels include: • Shike, set in medieval Japan. • All Things Are Lights, a story that entwines the fate of Cathars of southern France with the occult traditions of Courtly Love and the troubadours. • The Saracen, describing the intricate politics of medieval Italy through the eyes of an Islamic warrior. • Shaman, tracing the fate of the survivors of the Black Hawk War in 19th century Illinois. • Lady Yang, a tragic story of an idealistic empress of medieval China. (forthcoming)

A celebratory reading of Bob's works took place on March 26th, in Winnetka, Illinois. More than 100 people attended and many, including Bob's collaborator and dear friend Robert Anton Wilson, spoke during the meditative interlude of Bob's friendliness and curiosity, cheerfulness and courage.

Patricia thanks everyone for their support, especially those who participated in Pray For Shea Day (Feb. 14, 1994). She assures us that, "it may seem like the prayers of hundreds of well-wishers went for naught. Certainly I had hoped for a dramatic improvement in Bob's health as result of the prayer day... yet curiously I believe our prayers may have been answered, for Bob's death was a guiet one, and he was very happy in the days before it."

In the next few years, several more of Bob Shea's works will be published, including a collection of essays.
